I assisted with adoptions at PetSmart a while and fostered some dogs. It was an amazing experience with some great stories! But, I was drawn to the fundraising part because we needed that. I had worked in sales some and began to focus on Muttfest. It started as a small event at Sam Houston Park

and we only made a few hundred dollars. Mary (fellow volunteer & co-chair) and I teamed up and worked on it every year and now the event makes over \$10,000.

I have several foster cats and a few of my own. I also have 3 dogs. I have rescued many dogs and gotten them back with their families or to good new ones. It is a rewarding experience to find homes for animals and to see the joy they bring. It's something I almost had to do. There wasn't any option. If you are led in a direction, there's really little choice in the process.
